4) Old Business

- a) **Westport Transfer Station**: The BOS will consider approval of special conditions to allow resumption of services by Solid Waste of Willits at its June 20th meeting. Possible action may include comments to the Board of Supervisors and other involved parties.
- b) **CDP#2017-0015** (**Risse**): This after-the-fact permit application is a response to a Notice of Violation (BC 2016-0025) for construction of a two story guest cottage. Possible action may include comments to the County Planning Department.

5) New Business

- a) **CDP#2017-0011 (Amator)**: This permit covers removal of a 1440 sf house and replacement with a 2339 sf new single family residence in the Ocean Meadows subdivision. - b) **Assembly Bill 1129 (Stone):** A proposed law restricts protection of oceanfront property and improvements from ocean effects. (see: https://openstates.org/ca/bills/20172018/AB1129/ Possible action includes comments to Assemblyman Wood.

The WMAC may take action on off-agenda items according to Section 54954.2 the Brown Act when:

- a) a majority vote determines that an "emergency situation" exists as defined in Section 54956.5; or
- b) a two-thirds vote of the body, or a unanimous vote of those present, determines that there is a need to take immediate action and the need for action arose after the agenda was legally posted; or
- c) the item was continued from a legally posted meeting not more than five calendar days prior.
